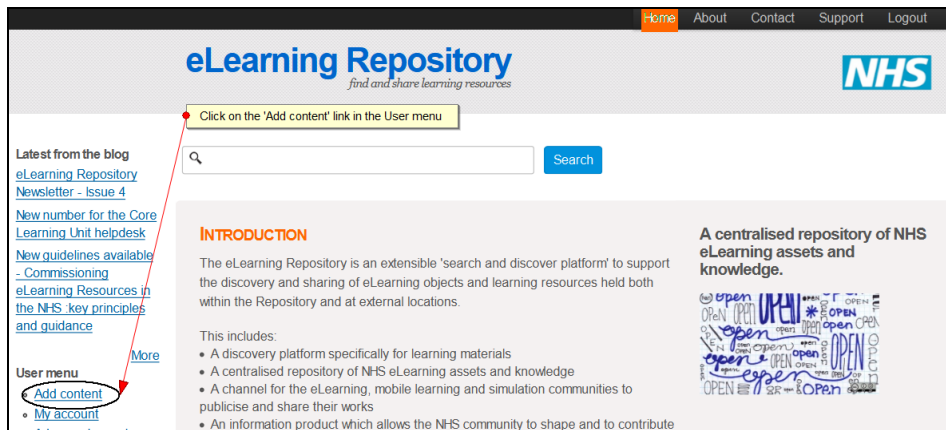


# eLearning Repository – how to add YouTube videos

Once you're logged in to the eLearning repository, you will have access to the *User menu* on the left side of the page. This is where you'll find the link to 'Add content'.



The 'Add content' link in the user menu will open the form to add new resource to the repository.

Required fields are marked with an asterisk (\*). These details help users find the resource so please be as accurate and descriptive as possible.

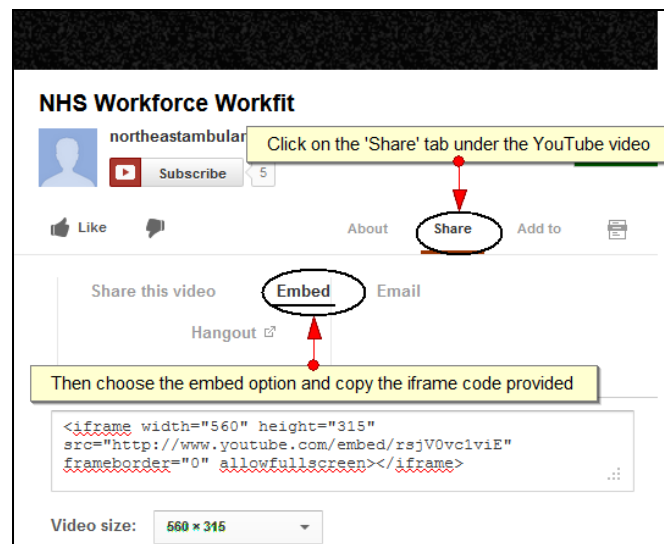
## General details

These details help users find the resource so please be as accurate and descriptive as possible.

- Title
- Description
- Keywords
- Version
- Status
- URL

It's helpful to add the source URL for the YouTube records, even if you plan to embed the video.

## Get the embed code from YouTube




## Add the video to the repository using 'Upload files' option


